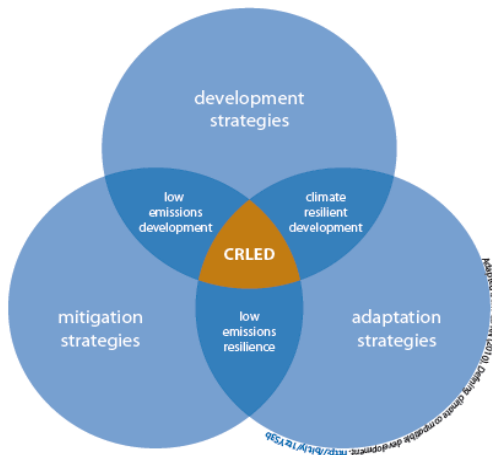

# Addressing Vulnerability Concerns in LEDS Planning and Implementation

IPCC Fifth Assessment Report (2014) explicitly links mitigation and adaptation; reviews synergies and conflicts in each sector-specific chapter

*"Many adaptation and mitigation options can help address climate change, **but no single option is sufficient by itself.**"*



*"Understanding how **to enhance positive feedbacks** between mitigation, adaptation, and sustainable development (e.g. win-win and triple win interventions) **while minimizing potential tradeoffs between them...** is an essential part of planning for and pursuing climate-resilient pathways."*

*Mayor of the Municipality of Roxas, Palawan, Philippines*

Maria Angela Sabando is a second term Mayor of the Municipality of Roxas, Palawan, serving since July 2010. During her term, the Municipality of Roxas was awarded the Seal of Good Housekeeping for two consecutive years, 2011 (Bronze Grade) and 2012 (Silver Grade), for complying with the Full Disclosure Policy on vital transactions and for showing strong adherence to transparency, accountability and performance as the core values of good governance. She also served as the Roxas Municipal Coordinator on Social Services from 2001 to 2009. Mayor Sabando is a strong advocate of environmental conservation and renewable energy in the Philippines.

*Senior Policy and Regulatory Advisor, USAID Indonesia Clean Energy Development (ICED) Project*

ICED provides advisory services to national and local government, project developers, banks and financial institutions, and PLN (the national utility). Ami has a wide range of involvement in the energy sector in Indonesia. She led the Indonesian Institute for Energy Economics (IIEE, a not-for-profit research institution focusing in energy policy and implementations) since 2003 and currently chairs the IIEE Executive Board. During 2006-2009 she was an energy expert for the Board of Commissaries of PT PLN (Persero), the state-owned electricity utility company. She was a member of the Oil and Gas Production Improvement Monitoring Team in 2009, which directly report to the Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources. She holds both PhD and MA in Economics from the University of Hawaii at Manoa, and Bachelor in Mathematics from the Bandung Institute of Technology in Indonesia.
