## LEDS and Multi-criteria Analysis (MCA)

- Successful implementation of LEDS requires consideration of **environmental**, **economic**, and **social** considerations
- Triple bottom line (TBL) valuation considers these three objectives on **equal footing**
- MCA can be used to guide decision making when there are **multiple objectives** to consider

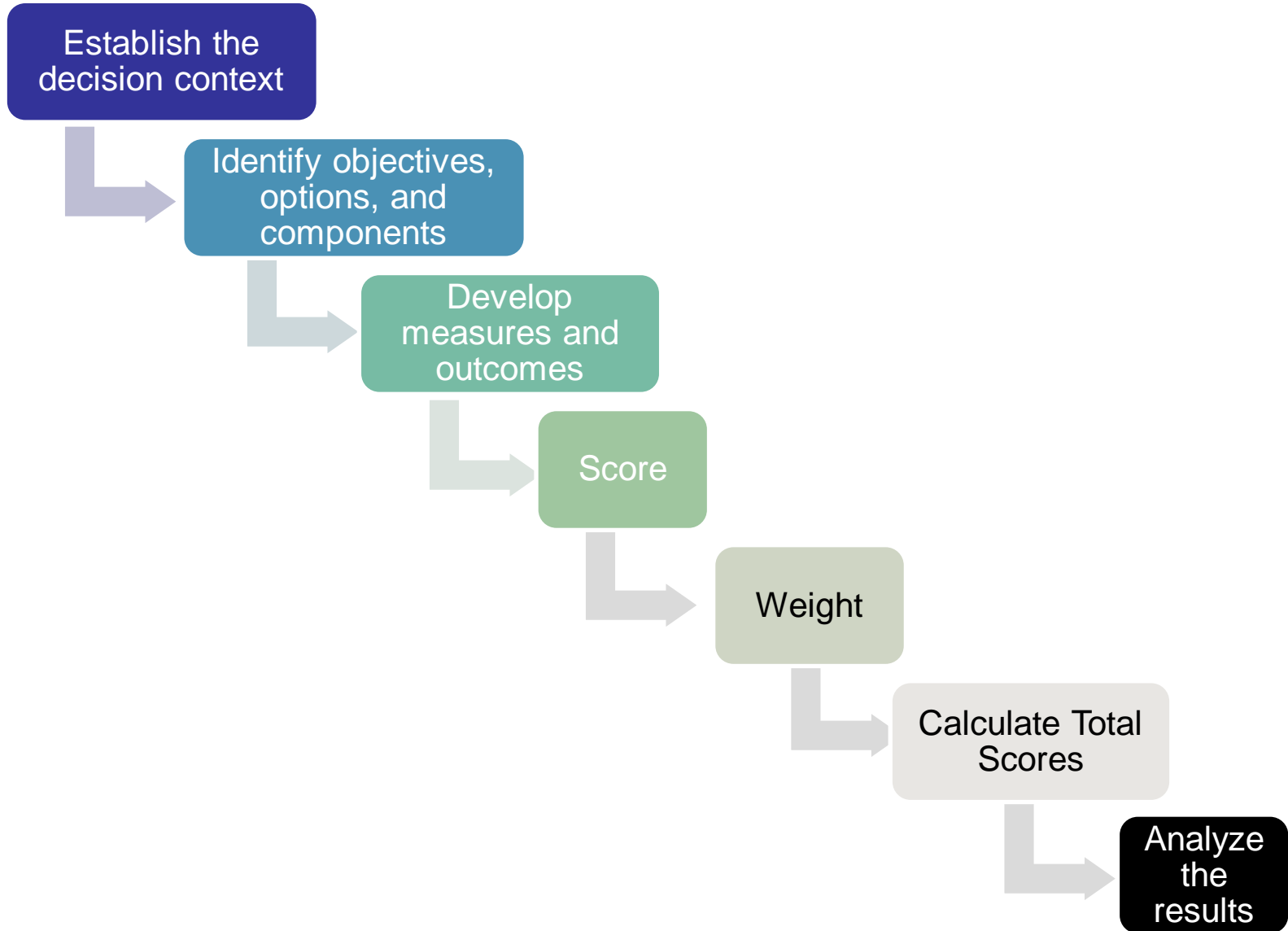

# When to use MCA

## MCA can be applied in different ways:

- Determine the highest ranked option from a set of choices
- Rank a set of options from most to least preferred
- Develop a short list of options
- Determine all options achieving a given threshold score
