Annotated Protocol for Carbon Stock Assessment of Mangrove Forests

Presented by: USAID Low Emissions Asian Development (LEAD) Program (ICF International)

Content type: Resource

Description: This new multimedia guide was developed to assist field researchers and practitioners in collecting data necessary for assessing the carbon stocks of mangrove forests. The annotated protocol complements the document "Protocols for the Measurement, Monitoring and Reporting of Structure, Biomass and Carbon Stocks in Mangrove Forests" by providing simplified instructions, video clips from field work, animation, and downloadable field data sheets.

Climate Change International Technical and Training Center (CITC)

Indonesia Climate Change Trust Fund

Description: Designed for mobilising, managing, and allocating funds received from various sources such as international donors, communities as well as private sector blending with government contribution to finance Indonesia's climate change projects and programs within the national mitigation and adaptation target.

IPCC AR5 Report: CDKN's Toolkit for Understanding the Evidence

Description: CDKN has launched a resource pack to spark discussion about climate trends and action on climate change in developing countries. Using infographics, images and slide packs, this toolkit is intended to help journalists and other communicators, policy-makers, development workers, civil society groups and businesses spread the IPCC's messages in their professional communities and integrate findings in their work.

Model for Pro-poor and Low-emissions Waste Management in Asia-Pacific

Description: ESCAP, in partnership with Waste Concern, an NGO in Bangladesh, is promoting the concept of waste to resource in Asia-Pacific through the Integrated Resource Recovery Center model. This model can convert waste into resources through a low-cost, decentralized, pro-poor and low-emissions approach and is particularly suitable for secondary cities and small towns.

MRV and Data Management

Presented by: World Resources Institute

Content type: Resource

Description: The display will introduce GHG reporting programs and data management systems for measuring, reporting and verifying emissions from industries, and highlights several program design related elements that policymakers need to consider when establishing effective MRV systems. These include institutional and legal structures, emissions coverage thresholds, emissions quantification methodologies, data management platforms, reporting requirements, and emissions verification and accreditation procedures.
